We are delighted that you supported your school signing up to the online payment system School Money. This means that you will now have the facility to make payments for school expenses, such as trips, online with your debit or credit card.

You won't need to sign up to this system as this is done automatically through the school and as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details we will send you a password within the next few weeks. This password will give you access to your School-Money account where you can pay for any items we have requested from you.

To log into SchoolMoney, visit the website www.eduspot.co.uk and click on the sign in button in the top right hand corner. In the drop down, select the SchoolMoney Parent Login option and this will send you through to a page where you need to enter your mobile num-

ber, email address, the password we have sent to you, and your child's first name. If for any reason you are struggling to log in, it may be because you have not provided us with the correct contact details. Please let us know immediately if either your mobile number or email address changes. We appreciate your cooperation in the early stages of rolling this system out to you.


Reward System


