

Drama tuition will begin again on Thursday 13th



# **Contingency Plans**

Class groups do not mix indoors during the school day with any other class group. Consistent groups are made up of staff and children. Those who mix during outdoor playtime are not considered to be close contacts.

If there is a positive case in your child's bubble a 'warn and inform' letter will be sent via whatsapp to inform parents of cases in the group.

At present substitute cover is critically low across all schools.

St Brigid's will do everything in our power to ensure school remains operational.

Our strategy in the event of a teacher being absent is as follows:

Cover provided by NISTR registered substitute teacher/ teachers available in school at that time,

Split a class across the remaining classes - high quality planning and a consistent structured approach to teaching

and learning across school make it a viable short term option for children to continue with their relevant learning while being supervised by a teacher from another class/ substitute.

Our **last resort** will be a move to remote learning.
